Rules and Regulation

1. Date : 27th Aug – 2nd Sep, 2005
2. Venue : International Convention Center Jeju(ICC Jeju)

3. Events : 1) Men's Team 2) Women's Team
3) Men's Singles 4) Women's Singles
5) Men's Doubles 6) Women's Doubles
7) Mixed Doubles
4. Method of Play :
 - 1) Team Events – The competition will be conducted in 2 stages. In the first stage, the teams first playing each other in groups on the basis of round robin system. In the second stage, same position of the group shall play by progressive knock-out system to determine the final placing.
 - 2) Individual Events – All individual events shall be played by a single knock-out system. Matches in singles event shall be played in best of seven games. And all doubles matches shall be played in best of five games from 1st round to quarter final, but semi-finals and finals will be played with the best of seven games.
 - 3) Team Match Format(new World Championships format) – A team shall consist of 3 players. The order of play shall be A v X, B v Y, C v Z, A v Y, B v X. All team events will be played with the best of five games.
5. Entries and Closing Date :
 - 1) Each Association may enter five (5) men players and five (5) women players. Within the quota, each association may enter one (1) Men's Team and one (1) Women's Team, five (5) players for Men's Singles, five (5) players for Women's Singles, two (2) pairs for Men's Doubles, two (2) pairs for Women's Doubles and five (5) pairs for Mixed Doubles. Pairing of players from different associations

is not permissible.

2) Entries forms should reach the ATTU Secretariat-Hong Kong (one copy) and the Organizing Committee for the 17th Asian Table Tennis Championships in Seoul, Korea (one copy) before the closing date 22 July 2005. Each participating member is requested to send with the Entry Forms two color photos(3.5cm x 4.5cm) to the Organizing Committee for preparation of your Accreditation Card and recording.

6. Competition Rules : The current ATTU's Regulation for Asian Championships, ITTF's Law of Table Tennis and The Regulations for International Competitions shall be adopted in the competition.

7. Equipment : ITTF approved equipment shall be used.

8. Draw : The draw for Men's and Women's Team events will take place on 25th August 2005, 16:00 in Seoul, Korea. The draw for the five individual Events will take place on 28th August 2005, 17:00 in Venue. Representatives from the participating Associations are welcome to attend the draw.

9. Awards : Cups and medals shall be awarded to the winners of all events and medals shall be awarded to the second, third and co-third placing of all events.

10. Jury : The Jury shall consist of four (4) persons ;
Chairman of ATTU Technical and Rules Committee/Technical delegate, Referee who shall have the right to speak but not to vote, a nominee from ATTU Executive Board and a nominee from the Organizing Association. The Chairman of the Jury shall be appointed by the ATTU Technical and Rules Committee. The first meeting of the Jury and the team managers' meeting shall be held on afternoon of 26th August 2005 at the official hotel.

11. Hospitality :

1) The Organizing Association will provide hospitality for accommodation, meals and transportation in Jeju city from the dinner of 26 August 2005 to the breakfast of 3rd September 2005 for the following ;

- a. not more than 8 players including playing and non-playing captain competing in both the men's and women's event.
- b. not more than 4 players including playing and non-playing captain competing only in men's team event.
- c. not more than 4 players including playing and non-playing captain competing only in women's team event.
- d. not more than 2 players competing in the individual events only.
- e. One delegate to the ATTU Congress from each Association, if he or she is not already included in the nominated players listed above.
- f. All members of ATTU Ex-co Board, Full members of Technical and Rules Co., Coaching and Junior Committee Co. and Secretariat Staff. The chairman of Technical co and secretariat staff shall be

given hospitality 3 days prior to the commencement of the championships.

g. The expense of chairman of Technical Co / Technical Delegate including air passage to the championships and draw shall be borne by the organizer.

2) Same hospitality will be provided for Associate members, extra persons or for an extra period of stay at the expense of USD 90 per day per person for twin-sharing basis only. Those who require single rooms will have to pay USD 120 per day per person.

12. Racket Testing : Adhesives used to attach racket covering shall not contain a prohibited solvent and tests of prohibited solvents will be carried out at the Championships. A player whose racket is found to contain a prohibited solvent is liable to be disqualified from the competition.

13. Doping Control : Anti-doping control shall be carried out at Championships in accordance with ITTF and IOC rules. A player who is found to have contravened the anti-doping code of the ITTF or the IOC will be penalized.

14. Television : Participation in the 17th Asian Table Tennis Championships presumes the consent of the Association controlling the visiting players to the televising of the Championships for the showing anywhere of live or recorded television during the period of the event and within 23 calendar months afterward. The Association whose team or players participate the Championships shall use its best effort to ensure the co-operation of their officials and players with the Host Broadcaster and its agency for interview access for use in newspaper, TV reports, news-feed and highlight shows of the TV programming of the 17th Asian Table Tennis Championships – Jeju, Korea 2005.

16. Team Manager Meeting : A Team Manager Meeting will be held on 26th August 2005 at 17:00. All Team Managers are required to attend.

17. Opening Ceremony & Welcome Party : The Opening Ceremony and Welcome Party will be held at Seogwipo KAL hotel on the 26th August 2005 at 19:00. The dress for the marching post is either contingent uniform or track suit.

18. Closing Ceremony : The Closing Ceremony will be held in the evening of 2nd September 2005 at the venue at 18:00.
